Terms and Conditions of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for Solid Waste Management and Recycling

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between Govt. Gundadhur P.G. College, Kondagaon C.G. (hereinafter referred to as "the College") and Municipal Corporation, Kondagaon C.G. (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipal Corporation") for the purpose of implementing a comprehensive solid waste management and recycling program at the College. The parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Implementation of Waste Segregation System

- The College agrees to implement a comprehensive waste segregation system across the campus. This system will clearly distinguish between recyclable and non-recyclable waste, with a focused effort on reducing the volume of waste that is sent to landfills.
- The College will designate separate bins for recyclable materials (such as paper, plastic, and glass) and non-recyclable waste, ensuring that appropriate signage and labeling are placed prominently to guide users in the segregation process.
- The College will educate and encourage students, staff, and faculty to follow proper waste segregation practices.

2. Collection and Recycling of Segregated Waste

- The Municipal Corporation will assist the College in the regular collection of segregated recyclable materials from designated bins on campus.
- The Municipal Corporation will ensure that the collected recyclable waste is processed in an environmentally responsible manner, in accordance with local recycling regulations and standards.
- Both parties will coordinate the frequency and logistics of waste collection to ensure that the recycling program is efficiently managed.

3. Awareness and Training Programs

- The College will conduct regular awareness campaigns and workshops for students, faculty, and staff, highlighting the importance of solid waste segregation, recycling, and plastic waste reduction.
- The Municipal Corporation will provide technical support and expertise in the development of educational materials and workshop content.
- Training sessions will cover topics such as the types of waste that can be recycled, the benefits of recycling, and the environmental impact of waste mismanagement.

4. Feedback and Monitoring Mechanism
